What Is Go Sun Smart?

The National Cancer Institute is sponsoring the development of **Go Sun Smart at Work**, a program to reduce heat and UV over-exposure for people who work outdoors. Twenty companies with at least 50 employees who work outdoors are needed to test the new program.

Research Study Overview



- 50 employees will complete two online surveys about their sun safe behaviors and receive \$20 upon completion.
- 6 managers will complete two online surveys about sun safety procedures and receive \$25 upon completion.

Use Program for 6 months (Mar-Aug 2024)

- Group A
 - 10 organizations will receive the Go Sun Smart at Work online program to implement.
- Group B
 - 10 organizations will receive a set of print materials.
